THE FOREST ENACTMENT (No. 58).

SUNGEI SANTI FOREST RESERVE.

No. 264.—In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 3 of the Forest Enactment and in pursuance of section 12 thereof, the State Secretary, with the approval of His Highness the Regent in Council, constitutes the land described below and delineated upon registered plan No. G. 1/51 in the office of the Chief Surveyor, Johore, copies of which are deposited in the State Forest Office, a reserved forest, to be known as the Sungei Santi forest reserve.

DESCRIPTION.

District—Kota Tinggi. Mukim—Pengerang. Approximate Area—9,000 acres.

Boundaries:—

South-east:—Commencing at the most northerly point of lot 709, the boundaries of lots 709, 887 to a point on the western boundary of lot 887, then a line bearing 276°, length 5920 links to the junction of lots 560 and 1021; thence the boundaries of lots 560 and the northern boundaries of alienated land to a stone on the western boundary of lot 776. Thence a line bearing 186° 30' length 4000 links to the most northerly point of lot 7, thence lots 7, 1193, 9, 13, 12, 14, 15, 17, 1191, 780 to the most southerly point of lot 780. Thence a line bearing 232° 30', length 2890 links to the most easterly corner of lot 1142 whose boundaries are followed west and south to its most westerly point. Thence a line bearing 172° length 900 links to the most easterly corner of lot 994. Thence the northern boundary of lot 994 and the northeastern boundary of lot 993 for a distance of 6070 links, followed by lines with bearings and distances as follows:—

to the northeastern corner of lot 109. Thence a line bearing 20° 00', length 530 links to the Sungei Santi. Thence the left bank of the Sungei Santi downstream for 150 links. Thence a line bearing 200° 00', length 535 links to the northern boundary of lot 109. Thence lots 109, 993 and 364 to the most westerly point of lot 364. Thence to the right bank of Sungei Lipau on a bearing of 200° 260°.

West:—The sea coast across Kuala Santi for approximately 142 chains. Thence a line bearing 52° 30', length 3650 links to a stone on the south-western boundary of lot 372, thence lots 372, 249, 373 and 714 to a survey stone on the eastern boundary of lot 714, 4315 links north of its southeastern corner.

North:—Beyond the last mentioned survey stone it runs on bearings and distances as follows:—
