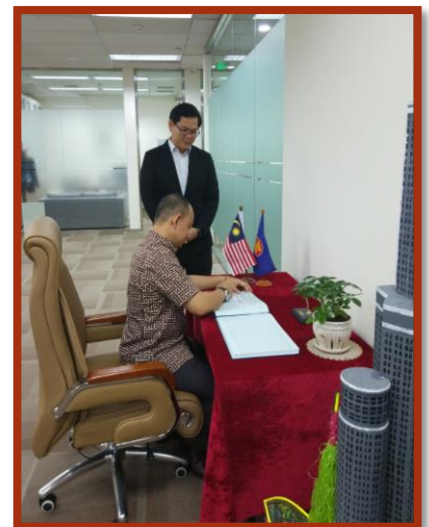

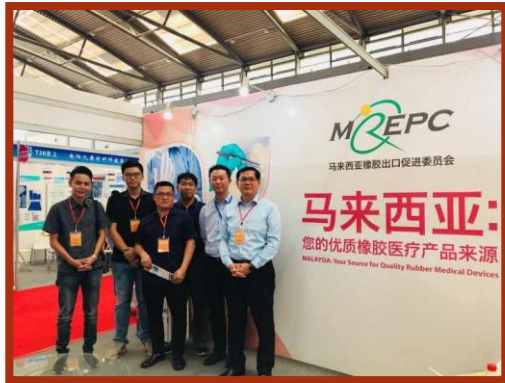

Consul General and Vice Consul were invited to participate in the 2018 Yangling Modern Agriculture Summit by the Foreign Affairs Office of the People's Government of Shaanxi Province on 5 November 2018 in conjunction with the 25th China Yangling Agricultural Hi-tech Fair (CAF) held in Yangling Agricultural Hi-tech Industries Demonstration Zone. The Xi'an Chapter of the Malaysian Chamber of Commerce and Industry in China (MAYCHAM China) successfully hosted its establishment ceremony on Saturday, 13 October 2018 at the Sheraton North City Hotel in Xi'an, which was attended by 180 local and foreign guests. The Chapter is the latest (4th) chapter of MAYCHAM China (which is registered in Beijing) in the Chinese mainland after Guangzhou, Shanghai and Kunming.

TYT Dato' Zainuddin Yahya, Ambassador of Malaysia to the People's Republic of China, who is also the Patron of MAYCHAM China was the Chief Guest of the event. Consul General and Mr. Will Fung Jui Seng, Chairman of MAYCHAM China were amongst the invited guests from the Malaysian side.

Consul General accompanied YB Tuan Tan Kok Wai to attend the “Global Chinatown Gathering in Chang’an – the Collection of Cultural, Commercial and Tourism Activities at Home and Abroad”, which was held on 10 to 11 December in Xi’an (Note: Chang’an was the ancient name of Xi’an). The event was co-hosted by the Chinese People’s Association for Friendship with Foreign Countries, Foreign Affairs Office of Shaanxi Provincial People’s Government, Shaanxi Federation of Returned Overseas Chinese and Xi’an Municipal Government. YB Tan was given the honour to present a keynote address as one of the invited foreign speakers at the Opening Ceremony of the Global Chinatown Gathering. The programme was mainly aimed at converging centripetal force of mainland Chinese and overseas Chinese for common development, promoting trade, investment, cultural and tourism exchanges with Xi’an (which is one of the oldest ancient capitals of the Chinese civilization) and help accelerate the growth of Xi’an as an international metropolis for Asia-Europe cooperation and exchanges.



FAST FACTS

Dunhuang is a city in China’s northwestern Gansu Province, on the edge of the Gobi Desert. Once a frontier garrison on the Silk Road, it’s known today for the Mogao Caves, a complex of 492 grottoes adorned with Buddhist statuary and frescoes. Carved into the cliffs above the Dachuan River, the caves were created between the 4th and the 14th centuries.

WORKING VISIT OF YB TUAN TAN KOK WAI, MALAYSIA SPECIAL ENVOY TO THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA AND CHAIRMAN OF MALAYSIA-CHINA BUSINESS COUNCIL TO XI'AN, 8-11 DECEMBER 2018

YB Tuan Tan Kok Wai, Malaysia Special Envoy to The People's Republic of China and Chairman of Malaysia-China Business Council conducted a working visit to Xi'an, Shaanxi Province, People's Republic of China from 8-11 December 2018.

YB Tuan Tan Kok Wai and delegation attended the "Global Chinatown Gathering in Chang'an – the Collection of Cultural, Commercial and Tourism Activities at Home and Abroad", which was held on 10 to 11 December in Xi'an. The event was co-hosted by the Chinese People's Association for Friendship with Foreign Countries, Foreign Affairs Office of Shaanxi Provincial People's Government, Shaanxi Federation of Returned Overseas Chinese and Xi'an Municipal Government.

China Council for the Promotion of International Trade (CCPIT) Xi'an Sub-council and the MCBC jointly organised a Malaysia-China Bilateral Trade and Investment Forum on 9 December 2018. 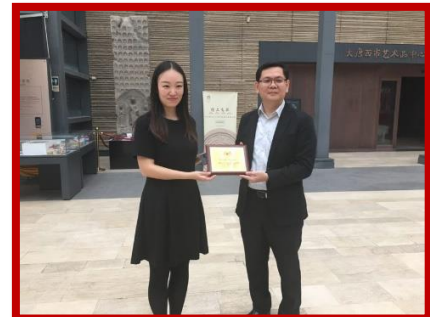

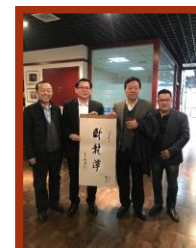
THE VISIT TO WEST TANG MARKET MUSEUM, 25 SEPTEMBER 2018

Consul General led all members of the Home-based Staff and PERWAKILAN Xi'an for a visit to the West Tang Market Museum on 25 September 2018. Ms. Emma Wei, Deputy Director of Membership Centre of the Silk Road Chamber of International Commerce and her assistant Mr. Alvis Lai, accompanied the Consul General for the tour to the said museum. The Tang West Market Museum is the first private on-the-site museum in China featuring the culture of the world famous Silk Road and it is located on the original site of the West Market from the Tang Dynasty (618-907). The exhibits on display reflect a long history ranging from the Shang Dynasty (16th-11th century BC) to the Qing Dynasty (1636-1911), including bronze wares, colorful porcelains, clay figurines in various appearances, shining gold and silver vessels, exquisite silk products, delicate jade carvings, a rich collection of ancient coins. At the end of the visit, Consul General presented a token of appreciation for the Silk Road Chamber of International Commerce for their hospitality.

Xi lauds Malaysia's Belt, Road role

Nations' leaders meet to discuss boosting relations

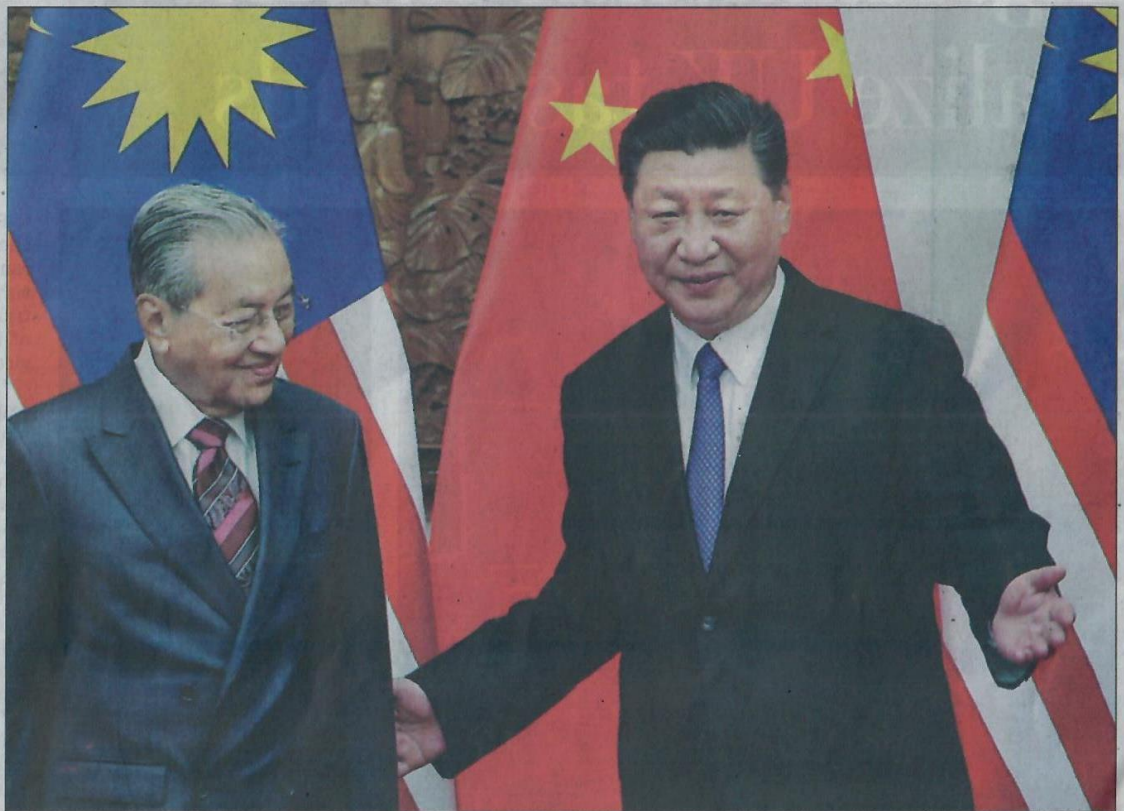

China and Malaysia should make jointly building the Belt and Road a main theme to advance their pragmatic cooperation in the new era, President Xi Jinping said on Monday.

Xi made the remark while meeting with visiting Malaysian Prime Minister Mahathir Mohamad at the Great Hall of the People in Beijing.

Hailing Malaysia as an important country along the ancient Maritime Silk Road, Xi praised it as one of the countries that supported the Belt and Road Initiative early on.

The two countries should boost the connection of their development strategies and enhance cooperation on industry and innovation, Xi said. He called on the two countries to cultivate new areas and explore new fields for cooperation and to expand their win-win cooperation.

马来西亚代表团此行将从 12 月 8 日—12 日到访西安，主要目的是为了加强与西安在文化旅游、农业、商贸、物流、新能源汽车、电子商务等多领域的合作交流，促进双边务实合作。在西安访问期间，马来西亚还赴陕西自贸区、国际港务区、灞桥区考察座谈。

拿督刘顺泰指出，沙巴位于东南亚的心脏地带，到东南亚及亚洲主要国家及城市都在 1 至 6 小时机程之内。加上沙巴地广人稀，政治稳定，拥有多元种族，各宗教和平相处，掌握英文、中文及马来文三种重要流通语言，无论文化、语言、价值观与国际接轨等多项优势。

“这一趟来到西安，实在让我大开眼界，西安不但拥有扎实的文化底蕴，在各方面的发展，包括旅游、教育、医疗、科技研发和工业都走在前端，各种景观都让人喜好。”

拿督刘顺泰表示沙巴和西安拥有很多相似的地方，比如重视自然环境、旅游发展，拥有卓越的

策略性地理位置；但双方也各有不同的优势，如沙巴拥有丰富的天然资源，气候土质有利农渔畜牧，良好的海陆网，一带一路倡议的推出对双方都带来庞大的契机。

西安向来拥有“控中原以通中亚”的地缘优势，肩负着中国陆权的重任，也是中国向西的支点，是华北华中华南西南进入新疆西藏的必经城市。而沙巴则处于通往东南亚及东盟东部增长区的心脏位置，是打开东盟 6 亿人口市场的主要闸门。

拿督刘顺泰指沙巴拥有足够的辽阔土地，丰富资源，未来两地能够借成策略伙伴，互补优势，取长补短，不但能够促成沙巴和西安两地经贸投资发展的双赢，更能辅助一带一路所能惠及的区域与落地与推动，最终打造大中华共荣区的金三角局面。

他也希望两地今后无论在政经文教各方面都能继续保持密切往来于合作，促成各方面的活动及项目的合作。

据悉，“世界唐人街 相聚长安城”其中一项重头戏“中国-马来西亚（西安）经贸合作推介会”已经在 12 月 9 日在西安市政府 2 号楼 1 层第 3 号会议室举行。

马来西亚中国商务理事会主席陈国伟、马来西亚经贸代表团、西安市政府领导、市政府相关部门负责人，各区县开发区领导，各商协会会长、国内知名企业 150 余人参会。此次活动由西安市人民政府、马来西亚中国商务理事会联合主办，西安市贸促会、西安市侨联、西安新丝路国际交流促进会承办，此次活动参加的国际经贸团有马来西亚经贸

合作，并希望加强两地文化交流与合作。

王勇副市长在会上致词时也表示，适逢“世界唐人街 相聚长安城”大型文商旅大集活动举行“中国-马来西亚（西安）经贸合作推介会”，将有力促进西安与马来西亚双方进一步开放市场，更广泛地开展务实合作，积极融入贸易自由化和经济全球化的历史大势。

“西安正围绕建设国际化大都市目标，加快打造“一带一路”创新驱动之区、全球硬科技之都、世界文化之都、世界旅游时尚之都、现代生态宜居之都和国际重要门户枢纽，积极构建陆海内外联动、东西双向互济的全面对外开放新格局。希望双方能以此次洽谈会为契机，进一步加强在文化旅游、农业、贸易、物流、建筑以及新能源汽车等多方面的合作，推动西安与马来西亚在港口、航空领域的互联互通，以点带面，促进各方面合作发展不断走向深入。”

马来西亚与西安的友好关系源远流长，此次活动将推动中马企业相互投资，实现资源共享、互利互惠。更好的为中马两国的友好往来，经贸交流提供服务，打造中马友好的新家园。
