

Perbadanan Harta Intelek Malaysia (MyIPO) telah ditubuhkan pada 3 Mac 2003 dengan berkuatkuasanya Akta Perbadanan Harta Intelek Malaysia 2002. MyIPO adalah sebuah badan berkanun yang bertanggungjawab ke atas pentadbiran dan pembangunan sistem harta intelek serta bertindak sebagai agensi Kerajaan di bawah Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri, Koperasi dan Penggunaan (KPDNKK). MyIPO mentadbir dan menguakuaskan Perundangan Harta Intelek yang terdiri daripada Akta Cap Dagangan 1976, Akta Paten 1983, Akta Hak Cipta 1987, Akta Reka Bentuk Perindustrian 1996, Akta Reka Bentuk Susun Atur Litar Bersepadu 2000, Akta Petunjuk Geografi 2000 dan Peraturan-Peraturan di bawahnya. MyIPO merupakan agensi tunggal yang menyediakan perkhidmatan pendaftaran harta intelek di Malaysia. MyIPO turut mengadakan program kesedaran mengenai kepentingan perlindungan harta intelek dan menyedarkan latihan harta intelek yang dikenalkan oleh Akademi Harta Intelek.

The Intellectual Property Corporation of Malaysia (MyIPO) was established when the Intellectual Property Corporation of Malaysia Act 2002 came into force on 3 March 2003. MyIPO is a statutory body responsible for administration and development of intellectual property system. MyIPO acts as an agent of the Government under the Ministry of Domestic Trade, Co-operatives and Consumerism (MDTCC). MyIPO administers and enforces Intellectual Property Legislation namely the Trade Marks Act 1976, the Patents Act 1983, the Copyright Act 1987, the Industrial Designs Act 1996, the Layout Designs of Integrated Circuits Act 2000, Geographical Indications Act 2000 and subsidiary regulations. MyIPO is the sole agency that provides intellectual property registration in Malaysia. MyIPO also organizes awareness programmes on the importance of intellectual property protection and provides training on intellectual property conducted by the Intellectual Property Academy.



PERUTUSAN MENTERI MINISTER'S FOREWORD

Bismillahirrahmanirrahim

Perbadanan Harta Intelek Malaysia (MyIPO) terus memamerkan prestasi yang baik dengan inisiatif-inisiatif baharu yang mendapat sokongan penuh dari pihak Kerajaan. Prestasi tersebut merangkumi kerjasama strategik bersama pelbagai pihak dalam meneruskan agenda pembudayaan dan pemerkasaan harta intelek.

Antara pencapaian yang dibanggakan adalah pemeteraan Memorandum Persefahaman bagi Penubuhan Technology Innovation Support Center (TISC) bersama tujuh buah universiti tempatan dan satu institusi penyelidikan yang akan bertindak sebagai Host Institutions. Projek TISC yang mengaplikasikan pendekatan Strategi Lautan Biru Kebangsaan ini adalah tepat pada masanya dalam usaha untuk mewujudkan kepakaran dalam bidang harta intelek dan pengkomersialan harta intelek di universiti dan institusi penyelidikan yang terlibat. Kejayaan projek ini dilihat mampu meningkatkan sumber kekayaan baharu negara melalui pembangunan inovasi dan kreativiti seterusnya meningkatkan kedudukan negara dalam Global Innovation Index.

Di peringkat antarabangsa, MyIPO telah mengadakan kerjasama dengan European Patent Office (EPO) dengan menandatangani Memorandum Patent Prosecution Highway (PPH) pada Oktober 2016. Program ini merupakan salah satu inisiatif untuk mempercepatkan proses pemeriksaan paten dengan menggunakan laporan pemeriksaan yang dikeluarkan oleh EPO. Program yang bermula pada 1 Julai 2017 dijangka dapat meningkatkan kualiti pemeriksaan paten dan seterusnya dapat menggalakkan permohonan paten antarabangsa di negara ini.

Intellectual Property Corporation of Malaysia (MyIPO) continues to present good performance through new initiatives with full support from the Government. The performance includes strategic collaboration with various parties in pursuing the intellectual property development and empowerment agenda.

Among the outstanding achievement was the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding for the Establishment of Technology Innovation Support Center (TISC) with seven local universities and a research institution that will act as Host Institutions. The TISC project which adopts the National Blue Ocean Strategy approach is timely in an effort to create expertise in the areas of intellectual property and commercialisation of intellectual property in the universities and research institutions. The success of this project would enhance country's new source of wealth through the development of innovation and creativity, thereby improving the country's ranking in the Global Innovation Index.

At the international level, MyIPO has collaborated with the European Patent Office (EPO) through a Memorandum of Understanding on the Patent Prosecution Highway (PPH) in October 2016. The programme is an initiative to accelerate patent examination process by adopting the examination report issued by the EPO. The programme, which will commence on 1 July 2017, is expected to improve the quality of patent examination and further promote international patent applications in the country.

Pada tahun ini Kerajaan telah meluluskan Dana Pemfalan Harta Intelek melalui peruntukan Rancangan Malaysia ke-11 bagi tempoh 2016 hingga 2020. Dana ini dapat membantu para usahawan, belia, komuniti setempat dan juga pelajar untuk memfailkan permohonan harta intelek mereka. Selain itu, sempena 1 ASEAN Entrepreneurship Summit 2015, Kerajaan turut memperkenalkan Special IP Filing Fund@1AES yang terhad kepada pemfailan cap dagangan, rekabentuk perindustrian dan hak cipta. Sehingga akhir 2016, sebanyak 100 harta intelek telah didaftarkan menggunakan dana Special IP Filing Fund@1AES tersebut.

Sementara itu, kerajaan telah menggumarkan penubuhan Music Rights Malaysia Berhad (MRM Bhd) sebagai sebuah badan tunggal kutipan royalti pada 8 Disember 2016. Badan ini akan berfungsi untuk menjalankan kutipan royalti bagi pihak empat badan pelepasan sedia ada dan seterusnya akan membuat pengagihan kepada badan-badan pelepasan tersebut berdasarkan kepada persetujuan bersama. Jika matlamat ini dapat dicapai, maka tiada lagi isu kekeliruan pembayaran royalti oleh pengguna karya berhakcipta.

Saya yakin, kejayaan inisiatif-inisiatif yang dilaksanakan oleh MyIPO jelas memberi manfaat kepada stakeholders, para pelabur dan seluruh masyarakat amnya dalam konteks pemilikan harta intelek. Saya optimis MyIPO akan terus memerlakukan mutu perkhidmatan untuk merealisasikan aspirasi Kerajaan dalam pembangunan ekonomi, kemajuan sosial dan inovasi.

This year the Government has approved the Intellectual Property Filing Fund under the 11th Malaysia Plan for the period of 2016 to 2020. The fund will help entrepreneurs, youth, local community and students to file their intellectual property applications. In addition, in conjunction with the first ASEAN Entrepreneurship Summit 2015, the Government also introduced the Special IP Filing Fund @ 1AES limited to the filing of trade marks, industrial designs and copyright. By end of 2016, a total of 100 intellectual property were registered by utilising the fund.

Meanwhile, the Government has announced the establishment of Music Rights Malaysia Berhad (MRM Bhd) as a single collective management organisation on 8 December 2016. The functions of MRM Bhd are to collect royalties and distribute to the four existing licensing bodies based on mutual agreement. Hence, issues on royalty payment by users will be resolved.

I believe the success of the initiatives undertaken by MyIPO would be beneficial in the context of intellectual property ownership among the stakeholders, investors and society. I am optimistic that MyIPO will continue to improve its service quality in achieving Government's aspirations of economic development, social and innovation.

Alhamdulillah, settinggi-tinggi kesyukuran ke hadrat Allah S.W.T kerana dengan limpah kurnia dan izinNya saya bagi pihak Perbadanan dapat membentangkan Laporan Tahunan MyIPO 2016.

Laporan Tahunan ini mengemukakan prestasi kewangan, pencapaian, aktiviti dan program yang dijalankan bagi meningkatkan kesedaran dan kefahaman mengenai hak harta intelek di kalangan masyarakat. Laporan ini juga memaparkan perancangan MyIPO bagi tahun 2017 untuk menambah baik tadbir urus dan memperkasakan regim harta intelek di Malaysia.

Prestasi Kewangan 2016

Pada 2016, MyIPO telah mencatatkan pendapatan keseluruhan berjumlah RM84.17 juta dengan penurunan 0.7% (2015:RM84.81 juta). Daripada jumlah tersebut, sebanyak RM74.74 juta adalah hasil operasi termasuk daripada pejabat cawangan iaitu penurunan sebanyak 0.2% (2015:RM74.92 juta). Pendapatan operasi adalah terdiri daripada hasil operasi cap dagangan RM47.06 juta, paten RM22.7 juta, reka bentuk perindustrian RM4.79 juta, hak cipta RM179.840 dan petunjuk geografi RM10.700.

Manakala pendapatan bukan operasi adalah terdiri daripada pelunasan Geran Kerajaan, pusat latihan, jualan aset, dan pendapatan faedah serta sewaan ruang pejabat turut menyumbang kepada pendapatan MyIPO berjumlah RM9.43 juta, menunjukkan penurunan sebanyak 4.6% (2015:RM9.88 juta).

Pencapaian 2016

Pada 2016, sejumlah 48,137 permohonan harta intelek telah diterima dengan peningkatan 5.5% (2015:45,623).

Financial Performance 2016

This Annual Report presents financial performance, achievements, activities and programmes organised to raise awareness and understanding of intellectual property rights amongst the society. The report also outlines MyIPO's 2017 plans for better governance and empower the intellectual property regime in Malaysia.

Achievement 2016

In 2016, a total of 48,137 intellectual property applications were received with an increase of 5.5% (2015: 45,623).

Daripada jumlah tersebut, sebanyak 39,107 adalah permohonan cap dagangan dengan peningkatan 8.9% (2015:35,923) dan 3,914 adalah permohonan Pemberitahuan Sukanera Hak Cipta dengan peningkatan 35.8% (2015:2,882). Manakala, permohonan bagi paten menurun sebanyak 6.5% iaitu 7,395 permohonan (2015:7,907), reka bentuk perindustrian menurun sebanyak 7.5% iaitu 1,630 permohonan (2015:1,762) dan lima permohonan petunjuk geografi dengan penurunan 83.9% (2015:31).

Bagi pendaftaran harta intelek sejumlah 38,073 pendaftaran dicatatkan dengan peningkatan (2015:33,022). Daripada jumlah pendaftaran tersebut, 3,353 adalah pemberian geran paten dengan peningkatan 15.3% (2015:2,908), manakala pendaftaran cap dagangan adalah sebanyak 32,806 dengan peningkatan 13.9% (2015:28,800). Permohonan reka bentuk perindustrian yang telah didaftarkan pula adalah 1,900 dengan peningkatan 46% (2015:1,301) manakala pendaftaran petunjuk geografi adalah sebanyak 14, menunjukkan peningkatan 7.7% (2015:13).

MyIPO sentiasa mempergiat aktiviti turun padang, promosi dan program seperti seminar, bengkel, latihan dan pameran mengenai harta intelek di seluruh negara. Aktiviti-aktiviti ini adalah sebagai usaha yang berterusan untuk meningkatkan kefahaman awam mengenai sistem harta intelek di samping mengalakkan pendaftaran harta intelek. Sepanjang 2016, sebanyak 273 program telah dijalankan di seluruh negara.

From the total, 39,107 were trade mark applications with an increase of 8.9% (2015: 35,923) and 3,914 were the Copyright applications of Copyright Voluntary Notification with an increase of 35.8% (2015: 2,882). Meanwhile, applications for patent decreased by 6.5% with 7,395 applications (2015:7,907), industrial designs decreased by 7.5% with 1,630 applications (2015:1,762) and five geographical indication applications decreased by 83.9% (2015:31).

For registration of intellectual property, a total of 38,073 registrations were recorded with an increase of 15.3% (2015:33,022). From the total registrations, 3,353 were patent grants with an increase of 15.3% (2015: 2,908), while 32,806 were trade mark registrations with an increase of 13.9% (2015: 28,800). For industrial designs, 1,900 applications were registered with an increase of 46% (2015:1,301) while 14 were geographical indication of registrations, indicating an increase of 7.7% (2015: 13).




Figure 1: Patent and Utility Innovation Applications (2012-2016)




Rajah 2: Sepuluh Negara Teratas bagi Permohonan Paten dan Perbaharuan Utiliti (2016)


Rajah 4: Pemberian Paten dan Perakuan Perbaharuan Utiliti (2012-2016)



Granted Patents and Certificates of Utility Innovation

In 2016, 3,353 patent grants were issued based on the fields of technology and the breakdown is as follows:

The fields of technology on human necessities increased by 26.9% with 688 patients (2015:542); performing operations, transporting decreased by 4.5% with 472 patients (2015:494); chemistry, metallurgy increased by 62.8% with 1,045 patients (2015:642); textiles, paper also increased by 4.4% with 36 patients (2015:25); fixed constructions increased by 13.7% with 183 patients (2015:161); mechanical engineering, lighting, heating, weapons, blasting decreased by 14.1% with 170 patients (2015:198); physics also decreased by 13.6% with 304 patients (2015:352) and electricity also decreased by 7.9% with 455 patients (2015:494). Statistics of Patents Granted Based on Fields of Technology are as shown in Table 4.







MyIPO received 90 applications for Trade Mark Expedited Examinations, a decline of 33.3% (2015:135). From the total applications, local applications recorded a decline of 54% to 52 applications (2015:113) while the international applications on expedited examinations increased by 72.7% to 38 applications (2015:22).


Request for Trade Mark Expedited Examination for international applications increase since MyIPO had managed to shorten the registration of a normal application to 8 months from the application date while the result of the examination will be released within a period of two months from the filing date.





Figure 10: Top Ten Countries for Trade Mark Registrations (2016)





Figure 14: Industrial Design Registrations (2012-2016)



In 2016, a total of 1,900 industrial design were registered, showing an increase of 46% (2015:1,301), 641 or 33.7% were local registrations while 1,259 or 66.3% were foreign registrations.







PRESTASI HARTA INTELEK INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY PERFORMANCES

Pejabat cawangan berfungsi sebagai pejabat penerima permohonan dan pendaftran serta menyediakan khidmat nasihat berkaitan harta intelek kepada masyarakat setempat.

Pejabat cawangan juga memainkan peranan meningkatkan kesedaran harta intelek dan memastikan maklumat disampaikan ke peringkat akar umbi. Pelbagai program kesedaran, seminar dan bengkel telah dianjurkan secara kerjasama dengan Kerajaan Negeri, pihak berkuasa tempatan dan masyarakat setempat.

Branch offices serve as reception points for applications and registrations as well as providing advisory services related to intellectual property for the local community.

The branch offices also play their roles in increasing awareness of intellectual property and to ensure that information is disseminated to the grassroots. To attain these objectives, various awareness programme, seminars and workshops were held in cooperation with State Governments, local authorities and communities.

1. Memorandum Perjanjian Penubuhan Technology and Innovation Support Center (TISC) di Malaysia

REGIONAL COOPERATION

1. Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) Participation on Establishment of Technology and Innovation Support Centre (TISC) In Malaysia

Bengkel Increasing the Capacity and Pace for Technology Scouting, Absorption, Adaptation through a "Hub and Spoke" Structure (Intellectual Property Hub) telah diadakan pada 21 Mac 2016. Pada bengkel tersebut, Memorandum of Understanding to Participate in Establishment of Technology and Innovation Support Center (TISC) telah dimeterai antara MyIPO dengan beberapa universiti dan institusi penyelidikan tempatan. TISC merupakan projek usahasmara MyIPO dan World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) dalam meningkatkan kemahiran harta intelek serta pengurusan carian informasi dan data paten di kalangan Host Institutions.

Program TISC merupakan salah satu inisiatif di bawah ASEAN Intellectual Property Rights Action Plan 2016-2020. Pada majlis tersebut, sebanyak tujuh universiti tempatan dan satu institusi penyelidikan telah menandatangani memorandum tersebut iaitu Universiti Malaysia (UM), Universiti Pertembahan Nasional Malaysia (UPNM), Universiti Sains Malaysia (USM), Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM), Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS), Universiti Sains Islam Malaysia (USIM), TATI University College (TATUC) dan Institut Penyelidikan Perhutanan Malaysia (FRIM).

Dengan termeterainya memorandum ini, Host Institutions akan dapat menyediakan dan menyebarkan maklumat teknikal dan komersial yang berguna seterusnya meningkatkan hasil negara melalui pembangunan inovasi dan harta intelek sejajar dengan misi meningkatkan kedudukan Malaysia di dalam Global Innovation Index.

2. Perjanjian Patent Prosecution Highway (PPH)

MyIPO signed two agreements on Patent Prosecution Highway (PPH) with European Patent Office (EPO) and Japan Patent Office (JPO). The PPH programme is an initiative that provides a means that significantly accelerating examination process of a patent application by using examination report issued by EPO and JPO.

Perjanjian PPH antara MyIPO dan EPO telah ditandatangani di Geneva pada Oktober 2016 dan akan bermula pada 2017. Manakala perjanjian PPH antara MyIPO dan JPO telah ditandatangani pada 2014 dan telah dilaksanakan sejak 2015. Sebanyak 172 permohonan PPH telah diterima dari JPO pada 2016.

3. EU-ASEAN Project on the Protection of Intellectual Property Rights (ECAP III Phase II) - ASEAN Intellectual Property Case Law Database

The PPH agreement between MyIPO and EPO was signed in Geneva in October 2016 and will come into force in 2017. Meanwhile, the PPH agreement between MyIPO and JPO was signed in 2014 and came into force since 2015. In 2016, MyIPO has received 172 PPH applications from JPO.

EU-ASEAN Project on The Protection of Intellectual Property Rights (ECAP) is a project between European Union (EU) and ASEAN. It aims to establish intellectual property case law database in ASEAN region.

As an ASEAN member, Malaysia through MyIPO completed 30 intellectual property cases for the database in 2016.

This database provides assistance to the judiciary body in analysing and deciding cases involving intellectual property. A part of that, this database increases the accessibility to cases and legislations in ASEAN region.

4. Perhimpunan Tahunan World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) ke-56

Perhimpunan Tahunan WIPO pada tahun ini telah diadakan dari 3 hingga 11 Oktober 2016 bertempat di ibu pejabat WIPO Geneva, Switzerland. Perhimpunan Tahunan ini telah dihadiri oleh lebih 100 negara ahli WIPO, organisasi kerajaan dan organisasi bukan kerajaan di peringkat antarabangsa.

Antara agenda utama perhimpunan tersebut adalah membincangkan laporan kewangan dan audit WIPO, keberhasilan aktiviti-aktiviti yang telah dilaksanakan serta isu-isu polisi berkaitan paten, cap dagangan, reka bentuk perindustrian, penutup geografi, pengetahuan tradisi, sumber genetik dan ekspresi budaya tradisi. Perkara lain yang turut dibincangkan adalah program-program bina upaya, perkembangan perkhidmatan harta intelek global dan triti-triti di bawah pentadbiran WIPO.

Malaysia telah berpeluang menyatakan pendirian negara berkaitan isu-isu yang dibincangkan bagi memastikan kepentingan negara dipelihara dan Malaysia turut mendapat manfaat dari program-program yang dilaksanakan oleh WIPO.

4. 56th Series of Meetings of the Assemblies of the Member States of WIPO

The 56th Series of Meetings of the Assemblies of the Member States of WIPO were from 3 until 11 October 2016 held in Geneva, Switzerland. The assembly was attended by more than 100 WIPO's members, international governmental and non-governmental organisations.

Among the main agenda discussed during the assembly are WIPO's financial report and policy issues concerning patents, trade marks, industrial designs, geographical indications, traditional knowledge, genetic resources and cultural expression. Besides that, the capacity of global programmes, development of intellectual property services and treaties administered by WIPO were also discussed during the assembly.

Malaysia had expressed her position on several issues discussed during the assembly to safeguard Malaysia's interest in the field of intellectual property as well as to gain benefit from WIPO's programmes.

5. The ASEAN Working Group on Intellectual Property Cooperation (AWGIPC)

Kerjasama serantau ASEAN dalam bidang harta intelek dikordinasi oleh ASEAN Working Group on Intellectual Property Cooperation (AWGIPC) yang telah ditubuhkan pada tahun 1996. AWGIPC merupakan badan sektorial yang terdiri daripada wakil pejabat harta intelek di negara-negara ASEAN.

4. 56th Series of Meetings of the Assemblies of the Member States of WIPO

a)Pematuhan negara ahli ke atas peruntukan Trade Related Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights Agreement yang baharu dan juga yang dipinda; b)Koordinasi berkaitan harta intelek, termasuk pengurusan dan pelaksanaan; c)Dialog berkaitan polisi ke arah pengukuhan regim harta intelek, profil harta intelek yang mesra pengguna;

- d)Kesedaran dan pendidikan mengenai IP peringkat serantau yang lebih baik;
 - e)Penambahbaikan hubungan serantau pejabat harta intelek di ASEAN.
- Starting from 2016, the AWGIPC has prepared a new Action Plan known as ASEAN IPR Action Plan 2016-2025 to replace the former ASEAN IPR Action Plan 2011-2015. This new action plan is a continuity of the former action plan that focuses on more comprehensive initiative due to modern development of intellectual property in ASEAN region. It is also aim to meet the goals of ASEAN Economic Community Framework (AEC).

ASEAN IPR Action Plan 2016-2025 contains four strategic goals with 19 initiatives that include all aspects of intellectual property. Each initiative has its own country champion from ASEAN member states and responsible to implement and observe the implementation of their planned activities. The strategic goals are:

5. The ASEAN Working Group on Intellectual Property Cooperation (AWGIPC)

ASEAN IPR Action Plan 2016-2025 telah menggariskan empat matlamat strategik yang mengandungi 19 inisiatif merangkumi keseluruhan aspek harta intelek. Setiap inisiatif tersebut mempunyai country champion yang terdiri daripada negara ahli ASEAN dan bertanggungjawab untuk melaksanakan atau memantau pelaksanaan aktiviti yang dirangka. 1. Courtesy Visit from The Office of The United States Trade Representative (USTR)

Pada 20 September 2016, MyIPO telah menerima kunjungan hormat dari The Office of the United States Trade Representative (USTR) yang bertujuan membincangkan hal tuju Perjanjian Kerjasama Trans Pasifik (TPPA) berkenaan harta intelek dan program kerjasama dalam pelbagai bidang antara Amerika Syarikat dan Malaysia.

2. Courtesy Visit from Deputy Registrar General, Ministry of Justice and Legal Affairs, Solomon Island

On 20 September 2016, MyIPO received a courtesy visit from the Office of the United States Trade Representative (USTR). The visit discussed on current issues pertaining to Trans Pacific Partnership Agreement (TPPA) as well as potential areas of cooperation between United States and Malaysia.

2. Kunjungan Hormat Deputy Registrar General, Ministry of Justice and Legal Affairs, Solomon Island

MyIPO telah menerima hormat dari Deputy Registrar General, Ministry of Justice and Legal Affairs, Solomon Island. Kunjungan hormat ini bertujuan untuk berkongsi maklumat mengenai perundangan, pentadbiran dan penguatkuasaan harta intelek di Malaysia. Pejabat Harta Intelek Kepulauan Solomon dalam proses menambah baik infrastruktur dan sistem perundangan harta intelek di Solomon Island.

3. Courtesy Visit from the Japan Patent Attorneys Association (JPAA)

MyIPO received a courtesy visit from Deputy Registrar General, Ministry of Justice and Legal Affairs, Solomon Island. During the visit, MyIPO shared information on legislation, administration and enforcement of intellectual property in Malaysia. Solomon Island Intellectual Property Office is in the midst of developing intellectual property infrastructure and legal system in their country.

3. Kunjungan Hormat daripada Japan Patent Attorneys Association (JPAA)

MyIPO telah menerima hormat dari Kinki Branch of Japan Patent Attorneys Association (JPAA) pada 11 Januari 2016. Pertemuan ini adalah untuk memperkenalkan JPAA dan perannya kepada MyIPO serta mengetahui lebih lanjut mengenai sistem pentadbiran harta intelek di Malaysia khususnya paten.

a) Strategic Goal 1:
A more robust ASEAN IP System is developed by strengthening IP Offices and building IP infrastructures in the region;

b) Strategic Goal 2:
Regional IP platforms and infrastructures are developed to contribute to enhancing the ASEAN Economic Community;

c) Strategic Goal 3:
An expanded and inclusive ASEAN IP Ecosystem is developed;

d) Strategic Goal 4:
Regional mechanisms to promote asset creation and commercialisation, particularly geographical indications and traditional knowledge are enhanced.

4. Kunjungan daripada Federation of Malaysian Manufacturer (FMM)

Pada 22 April 2016, MyIPO telah menerima kunjungan daripada Federation of Malaysian Manufacturer (FMM). Tujuan utama kunjungan ini adalah mendapatkan maklumat terkini mengenai perkembangan harta intelek dan bertukar-tukar pandangan mengenai isu-isu semasa yang melibatkan pihak industri. Antara isu yang disorbincangkan adalah berkaitan Pindaan Akta Paten, penyertaan Malaysia ke Madrid Protocol, pelaksanaan GST serta pengaruhnya terhadap barang tiruan.

3. Visit from Federation of Malaysian Manufacturer (FMM)

On April 22, 2016, MyIPO received a visit from the Federation of Malaysian Manufacturer (FMM). The main purpose of the visit is to discuss latest development and exchange views on current issues relating to intellectual property. Among the issues discussed are the Amendment of Patents Act, Malaysia's accession to the Madrid Protocol, implementation of GST as well as enforcement of counterfeit goods.

5. Lawatan Kajian daripada Peguam-peguam Skrine

Pada 15 November 2016, seramai 25 chambering students dari Skrine bersama tujuh peguam harta intelek dari China telah bertukar-tukar maklumat bersama MyIPO. Skrine merupakan antara ejen yang aktif di Malaysia dalam bidang harta intelek. Semasa lawatan tersebut, satu sesi penerangan telah diberikan mengenai perkembangan terkini undang-undang harta intelek yang sedang dipinda dan dilaksanakan oleh MyIPO. Selain itu delegasi turut melawat kemudahan bilik carian awam yang disediakan.

5. Study Visit from Skrine Lawyers

On 15 November 2016, 25 chambering students from Skrine and seven intellectual property lawyers from China made a visit to MyIPO. Skrine is one of the active intellectual property agents in Malaysia. During the visit, the delegations were briefed on latest progress relating to current amendment of intellectual property laws as well as MyIPO's activities. The delegations also visited public search room facility in MyIPO.



ENHANCEMENT OF SERVICE DELIVERY SYSTEM

1. Tadbir Urus Badan Pelesenan

Pada 2016, MyIPO dengan kerjasama pihak KPDNKK telah mengambil inisiatif menubuhkan sebuah badan tunggal kutipan royalti. Inisiatif ini adalah bagi memastikan hak dan juga royalti pemunya hak cipta ditadbir urus dan disalurkan secara lemah telus. Selain itu, isu kekeliruan yang dihadapi oleh pihak pengguna dalam membayar kutipan royalti dapat diatangani dengan baik dan berkesan.

Untuk tujuan tersebut, proses perbincangan bersama empat buah badan pelesenan sedia ada telah diadakan. Hasil daripada perbincangan itu, jawatankuasa sempena '(pro tem)' telah ditubuhkan pada 1 Mac 2016 bagi penyelarasan kerja-kerja penubuhan badan tunggal kutipan royalti dengan dibantu oleh MyIPO sebagai pemudah cara.

Badan tunggal kutipan royalti ini akan menjalankan operasi kutipan royalti terhadap pengguna karya muzik. Manakala badan pelesenan sedia ada yang telah diisytiharkan oleh Pengawal Hak Cipta akan menjalankan fungsi pengagihan royalti kepada ahli yang bernaung di bawah badan pelesenan tersebut.

Pada 8 Disember 2016, YB Menteri Music Rights Malaysia Berhad (MRM) sebagai badan tunggal kutipan royalti.

The function of the single collective management organisation is to collect royalties from the users. Meanwhile, the existing licensing body that had been declared by the Copyright Controller will carry out the function to distribute the royalty to their members.

On 8 December 2016, YB Minister of KPDNKK has announced the establishment of Music Rights Malaysia Berhad (MRM) as the single collective management



2. Penyediaan Draf Peraturan Notifikasi Pemberitahuan Pemberi Perkhidmatan

1. Governance of Licensing Body

In 2016, MyIPO with cooperation of KPDNKK have taken an initiative to establish a single collective management organisation to collect royalties. This aims to ensure the rights and royalties of copyright holders are administered and channelled transparently. Moreover, the issue of confusion faced by the users in royalty collection fees can be properly addressed effectively.

In respond to the above, a negotiation process was held with four existing licensing bodies. As a result, temporary committee (pro tem) was established on 1 March 2016 to coordinate the establishment of a single collective management organisation with the assistance of MyIPO as a facilitator.

3. Trade Mark and Geographical Indication Linkage (TMGI LINKAGE)

Draf peraturan ini merupakan satu garis panduan mengenai prosedur pemberian notifikasi dan tindakan yang diperlukan oleh pihak-pihak berkaitan untuk menyediakan platform komunikasi berhubung isu pelanggaran hak cipta dalam rangkaian elektronik. This draft is a guideline on the notification procedures and actions required by the related parties to provide a platform for communication regarding copyright infringement issues in electronic networks. It also provides a standardised format of a letter containing a minimum standard for the information required in a notification.

With the development of this system, registration of identical or similar trade marks and geographical indications can be avoided.

2. Preparation of the Draft Copyright Notifications Provider Regulations

In strengthening copyright law in the digital environment, MyIPO has prepared a draft on Copyright Notification of Service Provider Regulations.

4. Legal Awareness and Updates for MyIPO's Frontliners Programme

Legal Awareness and Updates for MyIPO's Frontliners Programme is an initiative to provide a better understanding on legal aspects and current cases relating to intellectual property to MyIPO's staff.

The programme was held from April to December 2016 and was participated by 80 staff mainly the front-line staff.

5. Workshop on IPR Enforcement Provisions of The Trans-Pacific Partnership Agreement

MyIPO dengan kerjasama United States Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO) telah menganjurkan Workshop on IPR Enforcement Provisions of The Trans-Pacific Partnership Agreement (TPPA) dari 28 hingga 29 November 2016. Bengkel ini bertujuan memberi pemahaman mengenai penguatkuasaan undang-undang sivil dan jenayah serta penguatkuasaan hak intelek termasuk penguatkuasaan di sempadan antarabangsa.

Peserta bengkel terdiri daripada pegawai MyIPO, Jabatan Peguam Negara, Jabatan Kastam Diraja Malaysia, Polis Diraja Malaysia, Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri, Koperasi dan Kepenggunaan (KPDNKK) serta Kementerian Perdagangan Antarabangsa dan Industri (MITI). Dengan menyertai bengkel tersebut, para peserta dapat berkongsi pendapat dan pengalaman berkenaan penguatkuasaan undang-undang harta intelek terutamanya dalam isu berkaitan rundingan TPPA.

5. Workshop on IPR Enforcement Provisions of The Trans-Pacific Partnership Agreement

From 28 to 29 November 2016, MyIPO in collaboration with the United States Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO) organised a Workshop on IPR Enforcement Provisions of The Trans-Pacific Partnership Agreement (TPPA). This workshop aims to provide understanding on the enforcement of civil and criminal laws as well as enforcement of intellectual property rights including cross border enforcement.

This workshop was attended by officials from Attorney General's Chambers, Royal Malaysian Customs Department, Royal Malaysia Police, Ministry of Domestic Trade, Co-operatives and Consumerism (KPDNKK), Ministry of International Trade and Industry (MITI) and MyIPO. During the workshop, participants had opportunity to share opinions and experiences on intellectual property law enforcement, especially issues relating to TPPA negotiations.

4. Program Legal Awareness and Updates For MyIPO's Frontliners

Program Legal Awareness and Updates for MyIPO's Frontliners merupakan satu inisiatif untuk memberikan kerahaman dari aspek perundangan dan pendedahan kes-kes semasa yang berkaitan dengan harta intelek kepada kakitangan MyIPO. Program ini telah disertai oleh 80 kakitangan MyIPO khususnya yang berurusan dengan pelanggan dan orang awam serta diadakan secara berkala dari bulan April hingga Disember 2016.

1. Pengauditan

MyIPO sentiasa berusaha untuk meningkatkan tahap pematuhan kepada undang-undang, peraturan-peraturan serta prosedur-prosedur yang berkaitkuasa untuk dilaksanakan dengan lebih efektif. Penilaian juga dibuat di peringkat pejabat cawangan bagi memastikan program dan aktiviti yang dijalankan berekonomi, cekap, berkesan dan mencapai matlamat organisasi dengan memberi penekanan untuk penambahbaikan pengurusan kewangan.

Sebanyak empat pengauditan prestasi, enam Penamplian Audit dan dua pengauditan susulan telah dilaksanakan pada tahun ini.

Hasil pengauditan pensijilan semula MyIPO berjaya mendapat sijil MS ISO 9001:2008 daripada pihak SIRIM berkaitkuasa sehingga 14 September 2018. Selain itu, MyIPO juga telah melaksanakan Sistem Pengurusan Kualiti MS ISO 9001:2015 berkaitkuasa 5 September 2016.

2. Konvensyen Kumpulan Inovatif dan Kreatif (KIK)

MyIPO turut menyertai Konvensyen KIK peringkat KPDKKK yang telah diadakan pada September 2016 dan telah memenangi Anugerah Khas Juri melalui projek, Sistem Mirror Correspondence.

3. Kemudahan Perubatan Insurans

Sebagai organisasi yang prihatin kepada keajikan kakitangan, MyIPO telah menyediakan kemudahan insurans perubatan untuk dimanfaatkan oleh semua kakitangan termasuk ahli keluarga. Setiap kakitangan diberikan manfaat perubatan yang boleh digunakan di hospital dan klinik panel.

1. Auditing

MyIPO has continued to improve its compliance with the laws, regulations and procedures to be implemented effectively. Evaluation was also conducted at the branch offices level to ensure the programmes and activities carried out are cost-effective, efficient, and productive as well as fulfilled the organisation's objective in improving its financial management.

There are four Performance Audit, six Appearance Audit and two Follow-up Audit were implemented this year.

From the result of the recertification audit, MyIPO has successfully obtained MS ISO 9001:2008 certification from SIRIM effective until 14 September 2018. MyIPO has also implemented MS ISO 9001:2015 - Quality Management System is effective on 5 September, 2016.

2. Innovative and Creative Circle (KIK) Convention

MyIPO has participated in the KIK Convention of KPDKKK which was held in September 2016 and won the Special Jury Award through a project named the Mirror Correspondence System.

3. Medical Insurance Facility

MyIPO provided medical insurance for the benefit of all staff, including family members to ensure the welfare of all staff are well taken care of. Each staff was given medical benefits which can be utilised at panel hospitals and clinics.

4. Pengukuhan Keselamatan Sistem Rangkaian

7. Manual Pengurusan Stor

Manual Pengurusan Stor diterbitkan sebagai panduan dan rujukan dalam melaksanakan tugas-tugas pengendalian stor serta menyelenggara inventori secara sistematis. Manual ini juga meliputi prosedur penerimaan, penyimpanan, pengeluaran, pemeriksaan, keselamatan, kebersihan, pelupusan, kehilangan dan hapus kira.

5. Budget Preparation System

Budget Preparation system was developed to enable the preparation of MyIPO's estimated expenditure and revenue annually. With the development of this system, MyIPO's budget will be monitored efficiently as well as to facilitate access and coordinate its financial.


6. Contract Management System

The development of the Contract Management system is aimed at ensuring all agreements related to MyIPO are documented systematically and easily accessible. The system also facilitates in monitoring the expiration date of an agreement to avoid delayed issues especially in the extension of the agreement period.

7. Stores Management Manual

The Manual of Stores Management is published as a guideline and reference in handling stores and managing inventory systematically. This manual also includes receiving, recording, storage, production inspection, safety, sanitation, disposal, loss and write-off procedures.

Empowerment of intellectual property culture is seen to increase the level of understanding on the importance of intellectual property ownership and further stimulate country's economy.

Various intellectual property trainings and programmes have been conducted by MyIPO to enhance human capital, skills and knowledge of the staff and stakeholders. The stakeholders consist of public and private sector, small and medium enterprises (SMEs), intellectual property practitioners, institutions of higher learning and research centers.

MyIPO has also organised and participated in 143 intellectual property awareness programmes on which 139 domestic and four foreign programmes. The main target groups for this year are entrepreneurs, teachers and school students. Besides that, MyIPO also organised 128 trainings, workshops and courses throughout 2016.

2. Program Trade Mark Do It Yourself (TMDIY)

Participants also were given the opportunity to get free pre-search and examination services.

The workshop aims to expose participants on the strategy of patent landscaping, mapping and analytics in analysing patent documents for industrial developments. The workshop also provides hands-on opportunity to analyse and share data based on guidance and supervision from WIPO experts.

Participants of this seminar were YPU entrepreneurs, Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs) entrepreneurs and law practitioners.

Sejumlah 420 orang pelajar Sekolah Berasrama Penuh dari Zon Utara, Tengah, Pantai Timur, Sabah dan Sarawak telah menyertai program tersebut. Program ini mendapat kerjasama bersepadu dari KPDNKK dan Bahagian Pengurusan Sekolah Berasrama Penuh dan Sekolah Kecemerlangan, Kementerian Pendidikan Malaysia.

Slot khas bersama guru pengiring dari setiap sekolah turut diadakan bagi tujuan perkongsian maklumat, pendedahan prosedur pendaftaran harta intelek serta mengenal pasti produk inovasi yang berpotensi dan layak untuk mendapatkan Dana Pemfailan Harta Intelek.

1. IP Filing Fund for Youth, Students and Local Communities

IP Fund was established under the 11th Malaysia Plan (RMKE-11) by the Government to help the youth, students and local communities who require financial resources for intellectual property filings.

With an allocation of RM 500,000, this fund will be able to spur innovative activities and intellectual property protection thus, stimulates the commercialisation activities among Malaysians.

This fund is specifically for the applications of five intellectual property components namely, patents, trade marks, industrial designs, copyright and geographical indications. Youth aged 18 to 40 years who are entrepreneurs, inventors, innovators and creators are entitled to apply for this fund. Meanwhile for student category, the application is provided to students of primary and secondary schools, colleges, vocational institutions which are recognised by the Government such as polytechnics, community colleges, higher skills colleges and training institutes. As for geographical indication applications, only local communities represented by organisations or associations in that area are qualified to apply.

Throughout 2016, a total of 742 applications were received under IP Filing Fund.

Various programmes organised by MyIPO have gained widespread coverage in printed and electronic media. Representatives from MyIPO's top management were interviewed by Malaysia Hari Ini (TV3), Selamat Pagi Malaysia (RTM1), Business Radio Station (BFM), Radio Nasional FM, Radio RTM Sarawak, Radio Melaka and Radio MACC FM. Ketua Pengarang MyIPO was interviewed in the special segment of Buletin Utama (TV3) on intellectual property awareness. MyIPO commercial advertisements have also been broadcasted on Radio Hot FM for promotions.

Announcements and information programmes as well as MyIPO's activities were also extended via social media such as Facebook, Instagram, Twitter and YouTube. MyIPO was awarded with Social Media Excellence Award in conjunction with the Malaysia Social Media Week Awards '16.

8. IP Summer Camp

IP Summer Camp programme 2016 was organised at the national level twice this year. Two schools were selected as the host for the programme. Sekolah Sains Sultan Haji Ahmad Shah, Pekan, Pahang and Sekolah Menengah Sains Raja Tun Azlan Shah (SERATAS), Taiping, Perak. A total of 420 students of boarding schools from Northern, Central, East Coast, Sabah and Sarawak have joined the programme. The programme was an integrated collaboration with KPDNKK and Bahagian Pengurusan Sekolah Berasrama Penuh dan Sekolah Kecemerlangan, Ministry of Education Malaysia.

A special session was also held with the assigned teachers in the programme. It aims to share information and filing procedures on intellectual property and to identify potential innovative products qualified for Intellectual Property Filing Fund.

2. Special IP Filing FUND@1AES

Special IP Filing Fund@1AES merupakan dana yang diperuntukan oleh Kementerian Kewangsaan Malaysia (MoF) sempena 1 ASEAN Entrepreneurship Summit 2015. MyIPO telah menganiurkan IP Connect iaitu program meningkatkan kefahaman perlindungan harta intelek dengan mengadakan aktiviti IP Talk, IP Clinic dan IP Filing. Sebanyak 100 harta intelek telah didaftarkan menggunakan dana tersebut yang terhad kepada pemfallan cap dagangan, rekabentuk perindustrian dan hak cipta.

Special IP Filing Fund@1AES is a fund allocated by the Ministry of Finance (MoF) in conjunction with the 1 ASEAN Entrepreneurship Summit 2015. MyIPO organised IP Connect programme to increase the level of understanding on intellectual property protection through intellectual activities such as IP Talk, IP Clinic and IP Filing. A total of 100 intellectual property applications consisted of trade marks, industrial designs and copyright have been successfully registered under this fund.



3. Dasar Twijuh Hari Latihan



"Empowering Intellectual Property as a New Economic Resource" was chosen as the theme for MyIPO Budget 2016, in order to achieve and fulfil the theme, five strategies have been outlined as follows:

- Strengthening intellectual property delivery system;
- collaboration with stakeholders and relevant agencies;
- increase understanding on the intellectual property value;
- enhancing capacity building of intellectual property leadership; and
- implementation of new initiatives.

In Financial Year 2016, MyIPO is expected to collect RM89.10 million from operating and other revenues. The details on the Estimated Operating Revenues and Other Income are as shown in Table 1.

Bagi memenuhi piauanan Laporan Entiti Persendirian Malaysia ("MPERS"), MyIPO telah mengambil pendekatan merombak pembentangan penyata kewangan seperti yang telah diwajibkan kepada semua yang telah diwajibkan kepada semua agensi Kerajaan pada 2016.

To comply with the Standards of Malaysian Private Entity Report ("MPERS"), MyIPO has taken the approach of revamping the presentation of financial statements as it is made compulsory to all government agencies in 2016.

The financial statements of the Corporation for the financial year from 1 January 2016 to 31 December 2016 are the first financial statement prepared in accordance of Malaysian Private Entity Reporting Standard ("MPERS"), which is the beginning of the earliest period presented.

The transition date of the financial statements is January 1, 2015. The Corporation provides for the opening of the statement of financial position of MPERS at that date by restating its financial position based on the new MPERS accounting standards.

The Corporation has used all mandatory exceptions from MPERS's full retrospective application. Previously, the Corporation presented the financial statements using Private Entity Reporting Standard ("PERS").





Jumlah Perbelanjaan Mengurus Sebenar bagi tahun 2016 berjumlah RM19.08 juta adalah terdiri daripada Belanja Emolumen RM36.24 juta (45.83%), Belanja Susut Nilai dan Pelunasan RM3.52 juta (4.45%), Perbelanjaan Perkhidmatan dan Bekalan RM34.98 juta (44.23%), Pembelian dan Bayaran Tetap RM1.31 juta (1.65%), Perbelanjaan Lain RM28.405 (0.04%) dan Kos Kewangan RM3 juta (3.80%). 



Actual income for 2016 was RM84.17 million compared to the previous year of RM84.81 million, indicating a decrease of 0.76%. Comparison of Actual Income for 2015 and 2016 is shown in Table 5.

Pendapatan Sebenar bagi 2016 adalah sebanyak RM84.17 juta berbanding tahun sebelumnya iaitu RM84.81 juta, menunjukkan penurunan sebanyak 0.76%. Perbandingan Pendapatan Sebenar bagi tahun 2015 dan 2016 adalah seperti di Jadual 5.



Perbelanjaan Mengurus Sebenar juga menunjukkan penurunan pada semasa jika dibandingkan dengan tahun 2015 iaitu sebanyak RM79,08 juta bagi tahun 2016 (2015:RM82,50 juta) dengan varians sebanyak -4.14%. Penurunan Perbelanjaan Mengurus ini adalah disebabkan oleh pengurangan dalam Belanja Emolumen serta Belanja Operasi yang terdiri daripada Perkhidmatan dan Bekalan, Pemberian dan Bayaran Tetap serta Perbelanjaan Lain. Perbelanjaan Susut Nilai turut menyumbang kepada penurunan Mengurus kesan daripada pelupusan aset dalam tahun semasa. Perbandingan Perbelanjaan Mengurus Sebenar bagi tahun 2015 dan 2016 adalah seperti di Jadual 6.

Actual Operating Expenditure also showed a decline in the current year compared to 2015 of RM79.08 million for 2016 (2015: RM82.50 million) with a 4.14% variance. The decrease in the Operating Expenditure is due to the decrease in Emolument Expenditure and Operating Expenses comprises Services and Supplies, Contributions and Fixed Expenditures and Other Expenses. Depreciation expenses also contributed to the decrease in Operating Expenditure as a result of the disposal of assets during the year. Comparison of Actual Operating Expenditure for 2015 and 2016 is shown in Table 6.





Report on the Financial Statements

Opinion

The financial statements of the Intellectual Property Corporation of Malaysia have been audited by my representative who concurred with the Statement of Financial Position as at 31 December 2016 and Statement of Comprehensive Income, Statement of Changes in Equity and Statement of Cash Flow for the year then ended, summary of significant accounting policies and notes to the financial statements as set out in pages 3 to 24.

In my opinion, the above-mentioned financial statements give a true and fair view of the financial position of the Intellectual Property Corporation of Malaysia as at 31 December 2016 and of their final performance and their cash flows for the year then ended in accordance with the approved financial reporting standards in Malaysia and the Intellectual Property Corporation of Malaysia Act 2002 (Act 317).

Basis for Opinion

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENT 2016

1) General Information

The Intellectual Property Corporation of Malaysia was established under the Intellectual Property Corporation of Malaysia Act 2010 [Act 31/2] located at Unit 1-1, Arau Pawai, Jalan 8, Bandar IJO, Bungku, No. 5, Jalan Bangku Utara 1, 59000 Kuala Lumpur.

The main activities of the Corporation are to provide services in administering, collecting and enforcing payment of prescribed fees of 3% and charges for trade marks, patents, industrial designs, copyright and geographical indications under the intellectual property law, supervising issues or matters relating to intellectual property in relation to the intellectual property legislation and creating awareness amongst public regarding the relevance of intellectual property through organizing programmes at national level and the dissemination of information on intellectual property.

The financial statements of the Corporation are presented in the functional currency, which is the currency of the primary economic environment in which the entity operates.

The functional currency of the Corporation is Ringgit Malaysia (RM) as the sales and purchases are mainly denominated in RM. Receipts from operations are usually received in RM and funds for financing activities are mainly generated in RM.

2) Date of Publication

The financial statements of the Corporation were approved by the Members of the Corporation on 03 July 2017 by circular resolution.

3) Significant Accounting Policies

The financial statements of the Corporation has been prepared in accordance with the Malaysian Private Entities Reporting Standard (M-PERS).

(a) Basis of Accounting

The financial statements have been prepared on a historical cost basis.

i. Transition to the new MPERS Framework

The Corporation's financial statements for the financial year from 1 Januari 2016 to 31 Disember 2016 and the its financial statement prepared in accordance with the MPERS, which is the beginning of the earliest period presented.

The financial statements' transition date is 1 January 2016. The Corporation prepares its opening MPERS statement if required section 47 tetara.

The Corporation has applied all the mandatory exceptions and certain of the optional exemptions from full retrospective application of the M-PERS. Previously, the Corporation presents the most recent financial statements using private Entity Reporting Standard (MPERS).

Except for the requirement to present separately items of other consumption income into those that will be classified subsequently to profit or loss and those that will not be recognised subsequently to profit or loss, the early adoption of the Amendments to MPERS has no effect on the financial statements of the Corporation for current year ended 31st December 2016 and the comparative year ended 31st December 2015.

(b) Property, Plant and Equipment

The carrying amounts of items of property, plant and equipment are derecognised on disposal or when future economic benefits are expected from their use or disposal. Any gain or loss arising from the derecognition of items of property, plant and equipment, determined as the difference between the net disposal proceeds, if any, and the carrying amounts of the item, is recognised in profit or loss. Fixed deposits are stated at cost, based on the amount deposited within the prescribed period.

(h) Cash and Cash Equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents in the statements of cash flows comprise cash and bank balances, short-term bank deposits and all cash equivalents. It is the liquid investment that have a short maturity of three months or less from the date of acquisition, net of bank overdrafts.

(i) Financial Liabilities

Financial liabilities are recognised in the statements of financial position when the Corporation becomes a party to the contractual provisions of the instrument.

On initial recognition, financial liabilities are measured at transaction price, includes transaction costs for financial liabilities not measured at fair value through profit or loss unless the arrangement, in effect, is a financing transaction for the Corporation to the arrangement.

After initial recognition, financial liabilities are classified into one of three categories: Financial liabilities measured at fair value through profit or loss, financial liabilities measured as amortised cost, or loan commitments measured at fair value less impairment.

A provision is recognised when the Corporation has an obligation at the reporting date as a result of a past event, it is probable that a future sacrifice of economic benefits will be required to settle the obligation and a reliable estimate can be made of the amount of the obligation. The risk and uncertainties are taken into account in reaching the best estimate of a provision, when the effect of the true value of money is material, the amount recognised in respect of the provision is the present value of the expenditure expected to be required to settle the obligation.

(l) Recognition of Grants and Provisions

The Corporation has allocated operational fund from its retained earnings as one of the facilities to its staffs yearly.

i. Retained Earnings

Contribution payable to the defined contribution plan are recognised as a liability and an expense while the employees have rendered services to the Corporation such as to the Employees Provident Fund ("EPF"), Social Security Organiser or ("SOCSO") and Retirement Fund ("KWW3") recognise as expenses in the Statement of Comprehensive Income.

Replacement of Annual Leave Plans (GLCR)

Replacements to Annual Leave are accounted for a period of one year. Provision for Replacement of Annual Leave is made based on 1/30 of the staff's last salary including Allowance upon retirement and total accumulated annual leave throughout his service at the Corporation.

(r) Financial Risk Management Policies

The financial risk management policy of the Corporation ensures sufficient financial and non-financial resources to carry out its operational activities effectively. The Corporation will consider and evaluate the financial risk management periodically as and when necessary.

i. Interest Rate Risks

The Corporation finances its new building from bank loan and therefore, is exposed to interest rate risks arising from bank borrowings.

ii. Foreign Currency Risks

The Corporation does not have any major currency transactions, assets, or liabilities and hence are not exposed to any significant on material currency risks.

iii. Credit Risks

The Corporation finances its new building from bank loan and exposed to credit risk.

iv. Liquidity and Cash Flow Risks

The Corporation practices prudent liquidity management to minimize the mismatch of financial assets and liabilities and to maintain sufficient levels of cash and cash equivalents to meet its working capital requirements.

IP Easy

Program *IP Easy* diwujudkan dengan objektif utama untuk membantu serta memudahkan permohonan harta intelek di kalangan usahawan. Pengisian program ini adalah terdiri daripada empat aktiviti utama iaitu *IP Talk*, *IP Advisory*, *IP Clinic* dan *IP Filing*. Kumpulan sasaran utama dari luar bandar yang belum mendaftarkan harta intelek.

Program TISC – Enabling IP Environment

Bagi menggalakkan aktiviti pengkomersialan hasil penyelidikan IPT dan institusi penyelidikan di Malaysia, MyIPO telah bekerjasama dengan WIPO dan juga IPT/RRI tempatan, melalui program yang dikenali sebagai *Enabling IP Environment*.

Objektif program ini adalah untuk mewujudkan persekitaran yang kondusif bagi penghasilan reka cipta, meningkatkan aksesibiliti terhadap maklumat-maklumat mengenai perlindungan harta intelek, penyediaan prasrama yang lengkap termasuklah program latihan *prior art search* sebagai panduan asas dalam membuat kajian mengenai teknologi baharu yang berpotensi untuk dipaten dan dikomersialkan.

Sistem Pengurusan Harta Intelek (SPHI)

Sistem Pengurusan Harta Intelek dibangunkan sebagai satu aplikasi yang bersepadu bagi menggantikan sistem sedia ada dalam memenuhi keperluan pengguna selaras dengan perkembangan teknologi terkini. Sistem ini menggabungkan lima komponen harta intelek yang utama iaitu cap dagangan, paten, reka bentuk perindustrian, petunjuk geografi dan hak cipta.

Kursus Patent Drafting Series: The Art and Mechanics Level 2 (Intermediate)

*IP Easy programme is designed with the main objective to assist and facilitate the filing procedures to entrepreneurs. There are four major highlights of the programme which are *IP Talk*, *IP Advisory*, *IP Clinic* and *IP Filing*. The main target group are entrepreneurs from the rural area who have not registered their intellectual properties.*

TISC Programme - IP Enabling Environment

*MyIPO has collaborated with WIPO as well as local IPT/research institute through a program known as *IP Enabling Environment* to promote the commercialisation of research and development from the university and research institutions in Malaysia.*

The objectives of this programme are to develop a conducive environment in creating inventions, increasing the accessibility of intellectual property protection information, providing a complete infrastructure which includes prior art search trainings as a guideline for future research on commercially viable technology.

Patent Drafting Series: The Art and Mechanics Level 2 (Intermediate)

This is a follow up of the current basic patent drafting course and designed to upgrade the technical skills in drafting patent's specification. Patent owners with good drafting techniques are able to get optimum protection if the drafting of patent claims are in accordance with the patent specifications.

Global Innovation Index (GII) Conference

MyIPO in collaboration with WIPO will organise the GII Conference to extend information on the criteria that influence the position in the index which measure the level of innovation of a country. The conference is expected to help improve Malaysia's position in GII.

MS ISO 9001: 2015 Certification
Implementation of the MS ISO 9001: 2015 aims to strengthen and enhance the service delivery system that focuses on the needs and expectations of customers. The implementation of this standard emphasizes on risk management and mitigation.

IP Curriculum for IP Academy

MyIPO with cooperation of WIPO will prepare professional certification courses in intellectual property to be implemented by the Intellectual Property Academy. This course will focus on the Professional Patent Drafting and Professional Intellectual Property Management Modules.
